- Increased Anxiety
- Initial Onset of Anxiety
- **Increased Depression**
- Initial Onset of Depression
- Increased Stress
- Initial Onset of Stress
- Social Distancing Can Be Isolating/Lonely
- Change in Routine Can Impact Medical Adherence
- **Support Services Decreased During Quarantine Restrictions**
- Priorities Change During A Crisis; Mental Health May Take A Backseat

Increased sense of physical and emotional danger, amplified by fear of a new disease with no treatment or

- **Food Insecurity**
- Illness of Friend/Family
- Death of Friend/Family
- Job Loss or Hours Reduction
- Lack of Income to Pay Rent
- Lack of Income for Medications/Doctor Visits
- Violence in the Home
- Re-traumatization

Increased Risk of Adverse Outcome and Decreased Funds/Resources
